Cancellation rules: Cancellation more than 12 weeks before the starting date of the presence days: 15% cancellation fee. Cancellation 12 weeks prior to the course up to 2 weeks before: 50% of the fee will be due. Any later cancellation will lead to no re-imbusement of payed fees and the entire fee would be due respectively. If the e-learning part is already accessed a minimum cancelation fee of 2000 Euro is due. Cancellations always have to be made in writing.
